Our restaurant service offers more than just a meal — it's a daily opportunity for residents to enjoy nutritious, home-cooked food, connect with others, and stay well. Located within Lace's Housing with Extra Care schemes, our restaurants form the social heart of each community.

We serve mainly freshly prepared, balanced meals seven days a week, using local Lincolnshire produce wherever possible. Residents, visitors, team members, and volunteers all play a part in creating a welcoming dining experience built on care, quality, and connection.

Home-cooked meals every day

Two-course lunches are served daily, with plated teas available to collect later in the day.

Menus follow a seasonal four-week rotation — offering traditional favourites, lighter options, and vegetarian dishes.

Meals are mainly prepared on site by our trained hospitality teams using locally sourced ingredients.

Each scheme displays its current menu and pricing clearly.

Pre-ordering made easy

To minimise food waste and ensure your meal choice is available, we use a simple pre-ordering system. If you haven't pre-ordered, for example you have been discharged from hospital, we'll always do our best to prepare a suitable meal for you.

Our restaurant team will help you choose and order in advance, making it easy to plan your week's meals.

Bringing guests

Family and friends are very welcome to share meals in our restaurants. To help us plan, please book visitor meals at least 24 hours in advance.

Visitor and leaseholder prices apply where no weekly restaurant charge is paid.

Special events — such as birthdays or small celebrations — can also be arranged directly with your hospitality team.
